## OMB dismisses appeal against Listowel drive-thru

LISTOWEL - A drive-thru restaurant proposed for the Listowel Carriage Shopping Centre is proceeding as planned after an appeal to the development was struck down by the Ontario Municipal Board.

The Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) hearing took place in Listowel on Aug. 9, where appellant Evan Argiloff made his case against the application put forward by the Listowel Carriage

Shopping Centre. A resident of Toronto, Argiloff testified that as a civil engineer, he felt responsible to act in the interest of public safety, and that his appeal to the development was strictly aca-

"As an engineer, I have to pro-

tect the safety of the public," Argiloff said. "I'm not antidevelopment.'

The drive-thru restaurant is proposed for the Carriage Shopping Centre between the Zehrs
