TREBUCHET RULES FOR PUMPKIN CHUNKIN'

- 1) Maximum counterweight 500 lbs.
If the weights cannot be removed to be weighed or otherwise verified, the judges' estimation will prevail.
- 2) The device must be gravity powered only. NO pneumatics, hydraulics or other energy sources.
- 3) Pumpkins will be selected by the judges for uniformity as close to 2 pounds as possible.
- 4) Entrants will be allotted 20 minutes to set up and fire 3 pumpkins
- 5) The judges may prevent a trebuchet from competing due to safety concerns
- 6) A backstop will be provided; trebuchets must be fired using a rope, lever etc. that allows the operator to be safely away from any moving parts.
- 7) Pre-registration is required.
