skill and sensitive portrayal of animals and Inuit people," the couple stated in an email.

"Sue indicated her desire to donate the funds raised from selling her art to the Aboyne Rural Hospice but was unsure how this could be done. We suggested having an art auction."

Dennis Novosad photographed and catalogued approximately 90 pieces of Hosking's art and placed each piece in protective sleeves. Cathy researched possible web sites for an auction and contacted Aboyne Rural Hospice to initiate and organize a sale.

"Sue got to see her photographed art before she passed away," Cathy said.

The online auction hosted by Rapid-Sell will be live from Sept. 22 at noon to Sept. 26 at 7pm.
