### **Grightmire** complete by August 2018

Arena construction schedule released

A detailed construction schedule released last week by the City of Hamilton states construction of the addition to J.L. Grightmire Arena will be completed Aug. 29, 2018, leaving a week for final inspection and walk-through before the substantial completion deadline on Sept. 7. The schedule produced by contractor Century Group Inc. leaves 10 days for "corrections of deficiencies" before total completion on Sept. 21, 2018.

University of Toronto professor of civil engineering Tamer El-Diraby, an expert in construction project management, said there is no standard scheduling practice and the length of time required for a construction project like Grightmire Arena depends on the number of crews working on the site at the same time.

"If the contractor puts in one crew, it will take (a) long time," El-Diraby stated in an email. "If the contractor puts in five crews, it will finish quickly."
